

Scripture Guide the Legend

Bold Blue font with double underline;

- Represents honor to God in scripture when He or Him is in the verse.
- Also used for God, Father, the Word, Jesus, and Holy Spirit etc...
- Also used for the Law God gave to Israel **before** the **free gift** of Jesus
- Also used for His thoughts, appearance, actions, and blessings in verses.
- Also for, Gods commandments, wisdom, knowledge, and understanding.

Black standard font;

- Used for storyline verses in Scripture.
- Also frequently used, to minimize man in character with God

Bold Blue font with double underline and *Italic*

- Represents Jesus name when the Father (God) is simultaneously in the verse or verses with Jesus Christ.

Slanted Black font; Either bold or standard are for words describing Jesus actions.

Bold Black font with either double red or double blue underline; (new feature)

- Double red represents **only** Gods warnings anger, punishment, grief or pain.
- Double blue represents **only** God's action, description, blessings or power.

Single Blue underline with **bold black font** (or sections of);

- Used for showing positive action and rewards of faith, according to God.
- Also used to designate anything Good according to God

Single Red underline with **bold black font** (or sections of);

- Used for words of Gods wrath and for anything opposing Him.
- Also used for God's sorrow and anything He's warning us about.
- And to bring attention to death and mans trials, sacrifices, and suffering.
- And to bring attention to the devil, and anything evil.

Bold Black font; Some words are **made bold, to help**, in presenting **the message**.

Yellow highlight;

- Brings extra attention to Gods warnings, blessings, **and will in scripture**.
- **Used for** both standard, and **bold font** depending **on** significance **of** verses **or** words, **in the scriptures message**.
