

Page # 2a / What does God look like?

Ezekiel 1:4-21 (NLT) As I looked, I saw a great storm coming toward me

From the north, driving before it a huge cloud

That flashed with lightning

And shone with brilliant light.

The fire inside the cloud glowed like gleaming amber.

[5] From the center of the cloud came four living beings that looked human,

[6] Except that each had four faces and two pairs of wings.

[7] Their legs were straight like human legs,

But their feet were split like calves' feet

And shone like burnished bronze.

[8] Beneath each of their wings I could see human hands.

[9] The wings of each living being touched the wings of the two beings beside it.

The living beings were able to fly

In any direction without turning around.

[10] Each had a human face in the front, the face of a lion on the right side,

The face of an ox on the left side, And the face of an eagle at the back.

[11] Each had two pairs of outstretched wings.

One pair stretched out to touch the wings

Of the living beings on either side of it,

And the other pair covered its body.

[12] They went in whatever direction the Spirit chose,

And they moved straight forward in all directions

Without having to turn around.

[13] The living beings looked like bright coals of fire or brilliant torches,

And it looked as though

Lightning was flashing back and forth among them.

[14] And the living beings darted to and fro Like flashes of lightning.

[15] As I looked at these beings, I saw four wheels on the ground beneath them,

One wheel belonging to each.

[16] The wheels sparkled as if made of chrysolite.

All four wheels looked the same;

Each wheel had a second wheel turning crosswise within it.

[17] The beings could move forward

In any of the four directions they faced, without turning as they moved.

[18] The rims of the four wheels were awesomely tall,

And they were covered with eyes all around the edges.

[19] When the four living beings moved, the wheels moved with them.

When they flew upward, the wheels went up, too.

[20] The spirit of the four living beings was in the wheels.

So wherever the spirit went, the wheels and the living beings went, too.

[21] When the living beings moved, the wheels moved.

When the living beings stopped, the wheels stopped.

When the living beings flew into the air, the wheels rose up.

For the spirit of the living beings was in the wheels. (verses continued 2b)

Page # 2b / What does God look like?

Ezekiel 1:22-25 (NLT) (Continuation from 2a) **There was a surface spread out above them Like the sky. It sparkled like crystal.**

[23] **Beneath this surface the wings of each living being stretched out To touch the other's wings, and each had two wings covering its body.**

[24] **As they flew their wings roared like waves crashing against the shore,
Or like the voice of the Almighty,
Or like the shouting of a mighty army.
When they stopped, they let down their wings.**

[25] **As they stood with their wings lowered, a voice spoke from beyond
The crystal surface above them. (Story verses continued next in K.J. verses)**

Ezekiel 1:26-28 (KJV) (continuation in King James verses) **And above the firmament**

That was over their heads

Was the likeness of a throne, as the appearance of a sapphire stone:

And upon the likeness of the throne

Was the likeness as the appearance of a man above upon it.

[27] **And I saw as the color of amber, as the appearance of fire round about within it,**

From the appearance of His loins even upward,

And from the appearance of His loins even downward,

I saw as it were the appearance of fire,

And it had brightness round about.

[28] **As the appearance of the bow that is in the cloud in the day of rain,**

So was the appearance of the brightness round about.

This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the Lord.

And when I saw it, I fell upon my face,

And I heard a voice of One that spoke.

Ezekiel 3:12-15 (NLT) **Then the Spirit lifted me up,**

And I heard a loud rumbling sound behind me.

(May the glory of the Lord be praised in his place!)

[13] **It was the sound of the wings**

Of the living beings as they brushed against each other

And the rumbling of their wheels beneath them.

[14] **The Spirit lifted me up and took me away. I went in bitterness and turmoil,**

But the Lord's hold on me was strong.

[15] **Then I came to the colony of Judean exiles in Tel-abib, Beside the Kebar River**

I sat there among them for seven days, overwhelmed.

Genesis 1:26-27 (KJV) **And God said; Let us make man in our (God and his son) image,**

After Our likeness: And let them have dominion over the fish of the sea,

And over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, And over all the earth,

And over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth.

[27] **So God created man in his own image,**

In the image of God created he him; Male and female created he them.

Page # 2c / What does God look like?

Daniel 7:9-10 (NLT) I watched as thrones were put in place and the Ancient One Sat down to judge.

His clothing was as white as snow, his hair like whitest wool.

He sat on a fiery throne with wheels of blazing fire,

[10] And a river of fire flowed from His presence.

Millions of angels ministered to Him,

And a hundred million stood to attend Him.

Then the court (of God) began its session, and the books were opened.

Daniel 7:9-10 (KJV) I beheld till the thrones were cast down,

And the Ancient of days did sit,

Whose garment was white as snow,

And the hair of His head like the pure wool:

His throne was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire.

[10] A fiery stream issued and came forth from before Him:

Thousand thousands ministered unto Him,

And ten thousand times ten thousand stood before Him:

The judgment was set, and the books were opened.

Daniel 7:13-14 (NLT) As my vision continued that night,

I saw Someone who looked like a man

Coming with the clouds of Heaven.

He approached the Ancient One and was led into his presence.

[14] He was given Authority, Honor,

And Royal power over all the nations of the world,

So that people of every race and nation and language would obey Him.

His rule is eternal

—It will never end. His Kingdom will never be destroyed.

Daniel 7:13 (KJV) I saw in the night visions, and, behold,

One like the Son of man came with the clouds of Heaven,

And came to the Ancient of days,

And they brought Him near before Him.

Daniel 10:4-6 (KJV) And in the four and twentieth day of the first month,

As I was by the side of the great river, which is Hiddekel;

[5] Then I lifted up mine eyes, and looked,

And behold a certain Man clothed in linen,

Whose loins were girded with fine gold of Uphaz:

[6] His body also was like the beryl,

And His face as the appearance of lightning,

And His eyes as lamps of fire,

And His arms and his feet like in color to polished brass,

And the voice of His words like the voice of a multitude.

Daniel 10:4-6 (NLT) **On April 23, as I was standing**

Beside the great Tigris River,

[5] I looked up and **saw a Man dressed in linen clothing, with a belt Of pure gold around His waist.**

[6] **His body looked like a** dazzling gem. **From his face came flashes like** lightning, **And His eyes were like** flaming torches. **His arms and feet shone like** polished bronze, **And His voice was like** the roaring of a vast multitude of people.

Ezekiel 8:1-4 (NLT) **Then on September 17, During the sixth year of King**

Jehoiachin's captivity, while the leaders of Judah were in my home,

The Sovereign Lord took hold of me.

[2] I **saw a Figure that appeared to be** a man.

From the waist down He looked like a burning flame.

From the waist up He looked like gleaming amber.

[3] **He put out what seemed to be a hand and took** me by the hair.

Then the Spirit lifted me up into the sky **and transported** me

In a vision of God to Jerusalem.

I was **taken** to the north gate of the inner courtyard of the Temple,

Where there is a large idol that **has** made **the Lord very angry.**

[4] **Suddenly, the Glory of the God of** Israel **was there,**

Just as I had **seen it** before in the valley.

Psalms 18:7-15 (KJV) **Then the earth shook and trembled;**

The foundations also of the hills **moved** and were **shaken,**

Because **He was** **wroth.**

[8] **There went up a smoke out of His nostrils,**

And fire out of His mouth devoured: coals were **kindled** by it.

[9] **He bowed the Heavens also, and came down:**

And darkness was under His feet.

[10] **And He rode upon a cherub, and did fly:**

Yes, **He did fly upon the wings of the wind.**

[11] **He made darkness his secret place;**

His pavilion round about him were dark waters

And thick clouds of the skies.

[12] **At the brightness that was before Him**

His thick clouds passed, hail stones and coals of fire.

[13] **The Lord also thundered in the Heavens,**

And the Highest gave his voice; hail stones and coals of fire.

[14] Yea, **He sent out his arrows, and scattered** them;

And He shot out lightning's, and discomfited them.

[15] Then the channels of waters were seen,

And the foundations of the world were discovered **at Your rebuke,**

O Lord, at the blast of the breath of your nostrils.

Page # 2e / What does God look like?

Exodus 24:10 (NLT) **There they saw the God of Israel. Under his feet**
There seemed to be a pavement of brilliant sapphire,
As **clear** as the **Heavens**.

Rev. 1:12-18 (NLT) **When I turned to see Who was speaking to me,**
I saw seven **gold lampstands**.

[13] **And standing** in the middle of the **lampstands was the Son of Man.**
He was wearing a long robe
With a gold sash across His chest.

[14] **His head and his hair were white like** wool, **as white** as snow.
And His eyes were bright like flames of fire.

[15] **His feet were as bright as** bronze refined in a furnace, **and his voice thundered**
Like mighty ocean waves.

[16] **He held** seven stars **in his right hand, and a sharp two-edged sword**
Came from His mouth.
And His face was as bright as the sun in all its brilliance.

[17] When I saw **Him**, I fell at **his feet** as **dead**.
But He laid his right hand on me
And said, "Don't be afraid! I am the First and the Last.

[18] **I am the living One who died.**
Look, I am alive forever and ever!
And I hold the keys **of death** and the **grave**.

Isaiah 6:1-6 (ESV) **In the year that King Uzziah died**
I saw **the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up;**
And the train of His robe filled the temple.

² Above **Him** stood the **seraphim**. Each **had** six wings: **with two he** covered **his face**,
And **with two He** covered his feet, and **with two he** flew.

³ And one **called** to another and **said: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts;**
The whole earth is **full of His glory!"**

⁴ And **the foundations of the thresholds shook at the voice of Him who called,**
And the house was **filled** with **smoke**.

⁵ And I said: "**Woe** is me! For I am **lost**; for I am a man of **unclean** lips,
And I dwell in the midst of a people of **unclean** lips;
For my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts!"

⁶ Then **one** of the **seraphim** flew to me, having in his hand a **burning coal**
That **he** (might angel) had **taken** with tongs **from the altar**.

⁷ And he **touched** my mouth and said: "Behold, **this** has **touched** your lips;
Your **guilt** is **taken** away, **and your sin atoned for.**"

Matthew 17:1-2 (KJV) **And after six days Jesus takes' Peter, James,**
And John his brother, **and brings** them up into an high **mountain** apart,

[2] **And was transfigured before** them: **and His face did shine as the sun,**
And His raiment was white as the light.

Page # 2f / What does God look like?

Isaiah 53:1-5 (KJV) **Who has believed our report?**

And to **whom** is the Arm of the Lord revealed?

[2] For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant,

And as a root out of a dry ground: He has no form nor comeliness;

And when we shall see Him,

There is **no** beauty that we should desire Him.

[3] He is despised and rejected of men;

A Man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief:

And we **hid** as it were our faces from Him;

He was despised, and we esteemed him not.

[4] Surely He has borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows:

Yet we did **esteem** (regarded) Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

[5] But He was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities:

The **chastisement** (punishment required for forgiveness from God) of our **peace**

Was upon Him; and with his stripes we are **healed**.

Genesis 1:26-27 (NLT) **Then God said, "Let us make people in our (God & Son) image,**

To be like Ourselves (God & Jesus). They will be masters over all life

—The fish in the sea, the birds in the sky, and all the livestock,
Wild animals, and small animals."

[27] **So God created people in his own image; God patterned them after himself;**

Male and female He created them.

Exodus 24:17 (NLT) **The Israelites at the foot of the mountain saw**

An **Awesome sight. The Awesome Glory of the Lord**

On the mountaintop **looked like a** devouring **fire**.

Isaiah 6:1-7 (KJV) **In the year that king Uzziah died**

I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up,

And His train filled the **temple**.

[2] Above it stood the seraphim's (mighty angels): each **one** had six wings;

With two **He** covered **his** face, and with two **he** covered **his** feet,

And with two **He** did fly.

[3] And one cried unto another, and **said, Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord of hosts:**

The whole earth **is full of His glory**.

[4] And the posts of the door moved at the voice of Him that cried,

And the house was **filled** with **smoke**.

[5] Then said I, **Woe** is me! for I am **undone**; **because I am a man of unclean lips,**

And I **dwell in** the **midst** of a people of **unclean** lips:

For mine eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts.

[6] Then flew **one** of the seraphim's unto me, **having** a live coal **in** his hand,

Which he **had taken** with the tongs **from off** the **altar**:

[7] And he laid it **upon** my mouth, and said, Look, **this has touched your lips;**

And your iniquity is **taken away**, and your sin **purged**.

Page # 2g / What does God look like?

Exodus 24:10 (KJV) And they saw the God of Israel: and there was Under His feet as it were a paved work of a sapphire stone, And as it were the body of Heaven in his clearness.

1 Kings 8:10-11 (NLT) As the priests came out of the inner sanctuary, A cloud filled the Temple of the Lord.

[11] The priests could not continue their work
Because the Glorious Presence of the Lord filled the Temple.

Psalms 18:7-15 (NLT) Then the earth quaked and trembled;

The foundations of the mountains shook; they quaked

Because of His anger.

[8] Smoke poured from His nostrils; fierce flames leaped from his mouth;
Glowing coals flamed forth from Him.

[9] He opened the Heavens and came down;
Dark storm clouds were beneath his feet.

[10] Mounted on a mighty angel, He flew, soaring on the wings of the wind.

[11] He shrouded himself in darkness, veiling His approach with dense rain clouds.

[12] The brilliance of His presence broke through the clouds,

Raining down hail and burning coals.

[13] The Lord thundered from Heaven; the Most High gave a mighty shout.

[14] He shot his arrows and scattered his enemies;
His lightning flashed, and they were greatly confused.

[15] Then at Your command, O Lord, at the blast of your breath,

The bottom of the sea could be seen,

And the foundations of the earth were laid bare.

Isaiah 6:1-6 (NLT) In the year King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord.

He was sitting on a lofty throne,

And the train of His robe filled the Temple.

[2] Hovering around Him were mighty seraphim, each with six wings.

With two wings they covered their faces,

With two they covered their feet,

And with the remaining two they flew.

[3] In a great chorus they sang, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty!"

The whole earth is filled with His glory!"

[4] The glorious singing shook the Temple to its foundations,

And the entire sanctuary was filled with smoke.

[5] Then I said, "My destruction is sealed, for I am a sinful man and a member

Of a sinful race. Yet I have seen the King, the Lord Almighty!"

[6] Then one of the seraphim flew over to the altar,

And he picked up a burning coal with a pair of tongs.

[7] He touched my lips with it and said, "See, this coal has touched your lips.

Now your guilt is removed, and your sins are forgiven."

Page # 2h / What does God look like?

Luke 9:28-36 (NLT) About eight days later Jesus took Peter, James, and John to a mountain to pray.

[29] And as He was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and His clothing became dazzling white.

[30] Then two men, Moses and Elijah, appeared and began talking with Jesus.

[31] They were glorious to see. And they were speaking of how He was about to fulfill God's plan by dying in Jerusalem.

[32] Peter and the others were very drowsy and had fallen asleep. Now they woke up and saw Jesus' glory and the two men standing with him.

[33] As Moses and Elijah were starting to leave, Peter, Not even knowing what he was saying, blurted out, "Master, this is wonderful! We will make three shrines— One for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah."

[34] But even as he was saying this, a cloud came over them; And terror gripped them as it covered them.

[35] Then a voice from the cloud said, "This is My Son, my chosen one. Listen to him."

[36] When the voice died away, Jesus was there alone. They didn't tell anyone what they had seen until long after this happened.

Matthew 17:1-2 (NLT) Six days later Jesus took Peter and the two brothers, James and John, and led them up a high mountain.

[2] As the men watched, Jesus' appearance changed so that his face shone like the sun, and His clothing became dazzling white.

Luke 9:28-36 (ESV) Now about eight days after these sayings He took with him Peter and John and James and went up on the mountain to pray.

²⁹ And as He was praying, the appearance of his face was altered, and His clothing became dazzling white.

³⁰ And behold, two men were talking with Him, Moses and Elijah,

³¹ Who appeared in glory and spoke of His departure, which He was about to accomplish at Jerusalem.

³² Now Peter and those who were with Him were heavy with sleep, But when they became fully awake they saw His glory And the two men who stood with Him.

³³ And as the men were parting from Him, Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is good that we are here. Let us make three tents, one for you And one for Moses and one for Elijah"---not knowing what he said.

³⁴ As he was saying these things, a cloud came and overshadowed them, And they were afraid as they entered the cloud.

³⁵ And a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is My Son, my chosen one; listen to him!"

³⁶ And when the voice had spoken, Jesus was found alone. And they kept silent And told no one in those days anything of what they had seen.

Page # 2i / What does God look like?

Ezekiel 1:1-18 (ESV) In the thirtieth year, in the fourth month, on the fifth day

Of the month, as I was among the exiles by the Chebar canal,

The heavens were opened, and I saw visions of God.

² On the fifth day of the month (it was the fifth year of the exile of King Jehoiachin),

³ The word of the Lord came to Ezekiel the priest, the son of Buzi,

In the land of the Chaldeans by the Chebar canal,

And the hand of the Lord was upon him there.

⁴ As I looked, behold, a stormy wind came out of the north, and a great cloud,

With brightness around it, and fire flashing forth continually,

And in the midst of the fire, as it were gleaming metal.

⁵ And from the midst of it came the likeness of four living creatures.

And this was their appearance: they had a human likeness,

⁶ But each had four faces, and each of them had four wings.

⁷ Their legs were straight, and the soles of their feet were like the sole of a calf's foot.

And they sparkled like burnished bronze.

⁸ Under their wings on their four sides they had human hands.

And the four had their faces and their wings thus:

⁹ Their wings touched one another. Each one of them went straight forward,

Without turning as they went.

¹⁰ As for the likeness of their faces, each had a human face.

The four had the face of a lion on the right side,

The four had the face of an ox

On the left side, and the four had the face of an eagle.

¹¹ Such were their faces. And their wings were spread out above.

Each creature had two wings, each of which touched the wing of another,

While two covered their bodies.

¹² And each went straight forward. Wherever the Spirit would go,

They went, without turning as they went.

¹³ As for the likeness of the living creatures,

Their appearance was like burning coals of fire, like the appearance

Of torches moving to and fro among the living creatures.

And the fire was bright, and out of the fire went forth lightning.

¹⁴ And the living creatures darted to and fro, like the appearance of a flash of lightning.

¹⁵ Now as I looked at the living creatures,

I saw a wheel on the earth beside the living creatures,

One for each of the four of them.

¹⁶ As for the appearance of the wheels and their construction:

Their appearance was like the gleaming of beryl.

And the four had the same likeness, their appearance

And construction being as it were a wheel within a wheel.

¹⁷ When they went, they went in any of their four directions

Without turning as they went.

¹⁸ And their rims were tall and awesome, and the rims of all four

Were full of eyes all around. (Verses continued on page #2J)

Ezekiel 1:19-28 (ESV) (continuation of verses from page #2i)

- ¹⁹ And when the **living creatures** went, the **wheels** went beside them;
And when the **living creatures rose** from the earth, the **wheels rose**.
- ²⁰ **Wherever the Spirit wanted to go**, they **went**, and the **wheels rose** along **with** them,
For the Spirit of the living creatures was in the wheels.
- ²¹ When those **went**, these **went**; and when those stood, these stood;
And when those **rose** from the earth, the wheels **rose** along with them,
For the Spirit of the living creatures was in the wheels.
- ²² **Over the heads of the living creatures** there was the **likeness** of an **expanse**,
Shining like awe-inspiring **crystal**, spread out **above their** heads.
- ²³ And **under** the expanse their **wings** were stretched out straight, **one toward another**.
And **each creature** had **two** wings covering **its** body.
- ²⁴ **And when they went**, I heard the **sound** of their **wings like** the **sound** of many **waters**,
Like the sound of **the Almighty**, a **sound** of tumult **like** the sound
Of an army. When they stood **still**, they **let down** their wings.
- ²⁵ **And there came a voice from above** **the expanse over their heads**.
When they stood **still**, they let **down** their wings.
- ²⁶ **And above the expanse** over **their** heads there was the **likeness** of a **throne**,
In appearance like **sapphire**; **and seated** above the **likeness** of a **throne**
Was a likeness with a human **appearance**.
- ²⁷ **And upward from what had the appearance of His waist**
I **saw** as it were **gleaming metal**,
Like the appearance of fire enclosed all around.
And downward from what had the appearance of His waist
I **saw** as it were the **appearance of fire**,
And there was brightness around Him.
- ²⁸ **Like the appearance of the bow that is in the cloud on the day of rain**,
So was the **appearance of the brightness all around**.
Such was the **appearance of the likeness of the glory of the Lord**.
And when I **saw it**, I **fell on my face**,
And I **heard the voice of One speaking**.

Ezekiel 8:1-3 (ESV) **In the sixth year, in the sixth month, on the fifth day**

- Of the month, as I sat in my house, with the elders of Judah
Sitting before me, **the hand of the Lord God fell upon me there**.
- ² **Then I looked**, and behold, **a form that had the appearance of a man**.
Below what appeared to be His waist was fire,
And above His waist was something like
The appearance of brightness, like gleaming metal.
- ³ **He put out the form of a hand and took me by a lock of my head**,
And the Spirit lifted me up between earth and Heaven and brought me
In visions of God to Jerusalem, to the **entrance of the gateway**
Of the inner court that faces north, **where was**
The **seat** of the **image of jealousy**, which **provokes to jealousy**.

Revelation 1:9-20 (ESV) **I, John, your brother and partner in the tribulation**

And the **Kingdom** and the patient **endurance** that are **in Jesus**,
Was on the island called Patmos

¹⁰ I was **in the Spirit** on **the Lord's day**, and I heard behind me

A loud voice like a trumpet

¹¹ **Saying, "Write what you see in a book and send it to the seven churches,**

To Ephesus and to Smyrna and to Pergamum and to Thyatira
And to Sardis and to Philadelphia and to Laodicea."

¹² **Then I turned to see the voice that was speaking to** me,

And **on turning** I saw seven **golden lamp** stands,

¹³ **And in the midst of the lamp** stands **One like a Son of man,**

¹⁸ **And the Living One. I died,** and behold **I am alive forevermore,**

And I have the keys of Death and Hades.

¹⁹ **Write therefore the things that you have seen,** those that **are**

And those that **are** to take place **after this.**

²⁰ **As for the mystery** of the **seven stars** that you saw **in My right hand,**

And the **seven golden lamp** stands,

The **seven stars** are the **angels** of the seven **churches,**

And the **seven lamp** stands **are the seven churches.**

Daniel 7:9-10 (ESV) "As I looked, **thrones were placed,**

And the Ancient of Days took his seat; his clothing was white as snow,

And the hair of His head like pure wool;

His throne was fiery flames; its wheels were burning fire.

¹⁰ **A stream of fire issued and came out from before Him;** A thousand thousands

Served Him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood **before him;**

The court sat in **judgment,** and the **books were opened.**

1 Kings 8:10-11 (KJV) **And it came to pass, when the priests were come out**

Of the **holy** place, that **the cloud filled the house of the Lord,**

[11] So that the priests **could not** stand to minister **because of the cloud:**

Daniel 10:1-17 (ESV) In the third year of Cyrus king of Persia

A Word was revealed to Daniel, who was named Belteshazzar.

And the Word was true, and it was a great conflict.

And he understood the Word and had understanding of the vision.

² In those days I, Daniel, was mourning for three weeks.

³ I ate **no** delicacies, no meat or wine entered my mouth,

¹⁵ When He had spoken to me according to these words,

"O my **Lord, by reason of the vision**

¹⁷ **How can** my **Lord's** servant **talk** with my **Lord?** For now **no** strength **remains in** me,
