John 6:63 (KJV) **It is the Spirit that quickens;**

The flesh profits **nothing**:

The words that I speak unto you, **they are Spirit,**

And **they are life.**

John 6:63 (NLT) **It is the Spirit who gives eternal life.**

Human effort accomplishes nothing.

And the very words I have spoken to you **are Spirit and life.**

John 4:23-24 (NLT) **But the time is coming and is already here when true worshipers**

Will worship **the Father**

In Spirit and **in Truth.**

The Father is looking for anyone who will **worship him** that way.

[24] **For God is Spirit,**

So those who worship **Him must** worship **in Spirit** and **in Truth.**"

John 4:23-24 (KJV) **But the hour comes, and now is, when the true worshippers**

Shall worship **the Father in Spirit** and **in Truth:**

For the Father seeks such to **worship him.**

[24] **God is a Spirit:**

And they that **worship Him must** worship **him in Spirit** and **in Truth.**

1 John 2:27 (NLT) **But you have received the Holy Spirit, and he lives within you,**

So you **don't need** anyone **to teach you what is true.**

For the Spirit teaches you all things,

And what He teaches is true

—It is **not** a lie.

So **continue** in **what He has taught** you, **and continue to live in Christ.**

Luke 24:49 (KJV) **And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you:**

But tarry you in the city of Jerusalem,

Until you be **endued with power from on High.**

Mark 13:10-13 (ESV) **And the Gospel must first be proclaimed to all nations.**

¹¹ And **when they bring you to trial** and **deliver** you over,

Do not be anxious beforehand **what** you are to say,

But **say whatever is given** you in that hour,

For it is not you who speak, but the Holy Spirit.

¹² And brother **will deliver** brother **over to death,** and the father his child,

And children will **rise against** parents and have them **put to death.**

¹³ And you will be **hated** by all for **My Name's sake.**

But the one **who endures to the end** **will be saved.**

May you overflow with hope through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Ephes. 5:18-19 (NLT) **Don't be drunk with wine, because that will ruin your life.**
Instead, **let the Holy Spirit fill** and **control** you.
[19] **Then you will sing psalms and hymns** and **spiritual** songs among yourselves,
Making music to the Lord in your hearts.

John 14:26 (KJV) **But the Comforter, this is the Holy Ghost,**
Whom the Father will send in My Name,
He shall teach you all things, **and bring** all things **to your remembrance,**
Whatever I have said unto you.

John 14:26 (NLT) **But when the Father sends the Counselor as My representative—**
And by **the Counselor I mean the Holy Spirit—**
He will teach you everything
And **will remind** you of **everything I myself have told** you.

Luke 24:49 (NLT) **"And now I will send the Holy Spirit, just as my Father promised.**
But stay here in the city
Until **the Holy Spirit comes** and **fills you with power from Heaven."**

Luke 11:11-13 (NLT) **"You fathers—if your children ask for a fish,**
Do you give them a snake instead?
[12] Or **if they ask for an egg, do you give them a scorpion? Of course not!**
[13] If you **sinful** people **know how** to give **good** gifts to your children
How much more will your **Heavenly Father**
Give the Holy Spirit to those who **ask Him."**

Galatians 5:22 (NLT) **But when the Holy Spirit controls our lives,**
He will produce this kind of fruit in us:
Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

Acts 9:31 (NLT) **The church then had peace throughout Judea,**
Galilee, and Samaria, **and it grew in strength** and numbers.
The **believers** were walking in the **fear** of **the Lord**
And in the **comfort** of **the Holy Spirit.**

Acts 19:2-7 (NLT) "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?"

He asked them. "No," they replied,

"We don't know what you mean.

We haven't even heard that there is a Holy Spirit."

[3] "Then what baptism did you experience?" He asked.

And they replied, "The baptism of John."

[4] Paul said, "John's baptism was to demonstrate a desire to turn from sin

And turn to God.

John himself told the people to believe in Jesus,

The One John said would come later."

[5] As soon as they heard this, they were baptized in the Name of the Lord Jesus.

[6] Then when Paul laid his hands on them,

The Holy Spirit came on them,

And they spoke in other tongues and prophesied.

[7] There were about twelve men in all.

Acts 8:15-17 (NLT) As soon as they arrived,

They prayed for these new Christians to receive the Holy Spirit.

[16] The Holy Spirit had not yet come upon any of them,

For they had only been baptized in the Name of the Lord Jesus.

[17] Then Peter and John laid their hands upon these believers,

And they received the Holy Spirit.

2 Peter 1:16-21 (ESV) For we did not follow cleverly devised myths

When we made known to you the Power and coming

Of our Lord Jesus Christ,

But we were eyewitnesses of His Majesty.

¹⁷ For when He received honor and glory from God the Father,

And the voice was borne to Him

By the Majestic Glory, "This is My beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased,"

¹⁸ We ourselves heard this very voice borne from Heaven, for we were with Him

On the holy mountain.

¹⁹ And we have something more sure, the Prophetic Word, to which

You will do well to pay attention

As to a lamp shining in a dark place,

Until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts,

²⁰ Knowing this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture comes from

Someone's own interpretation.

²¹ For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man,

But men spoke from God

As they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

Ephes. 4:30 (KJV) **And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God,**
Whereby you are **sealed** unto the day of **redemption.**

Ephes. 6:18 (KJV) **Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit,**
And **watching** thereunto with all **perseverance**
And **supplication** (to ask for humbly, earnestly) **for all saints;**

Romans 8:1-14 (KJV) **There is therefore now no condemnation to them**

Which are **in Christ Jesus,**

Who walk **not** after the flesh, but **after the Spirit.**

[2] For **the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus**

Has **made** me **free** from **the law of sin and death.**

[3] **For what the law could not** do,

In that it was weak through the **flesh,**

God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh,

And for sin, **condemned** sin **in the flesh:**

[4] **That the righteousness of the law might** be fulfilled **in** us,

Who walk **not** after the flesh,

But **after the Spirit.**

[5] For they that **are after** the flesh **do mind** the **things** of the **flesh;**

But they that are **after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.**

[6] For to be **carnally** minded is **death;**

But to be **spiritually** minded **is life and peace.**

[7] Because the **carnal** mind is **enmity** (ill will, hatred) **against God:**

For it **is not** subject to **the law of God,** **neither indeed can be.**

[8] So then they that are **in** the **flesh cannot** please **God.**

[9] **But you are not in the flesh,** but **in the Spirit,**

If so be that **the Spirit of God dwells** in you.

Now if any man **have not the Spirit of Christ,** **he is none of his.**

[10] And **if Christ be in** you, the body **is dead** because of **sin;**

But **the Spirit is life**

Because of **Righteousness** (gift from God through *Jesus*)

[11] But **if the Spirit of Him that raised up Jesus from the dead**

Dwell **in** you,

He that raised up Christ from the dead

Shall also quicken your mortal bodies **by His Spirit**

That dwells in you.

[12] Therefore, brethren, we are **debtors, not** to the **flesh,** to live after the flesh.

[13] For **if** you live **after** the **flesh,** you **shall die:**

But **if** you **through the Spirit**

Do mortify the deeds **of** the body, you **shall live.**

[14] **For as many as are led** by **the Spirit of God,** they **are** the **sons of God.**

Ephes. 4:3 (KJV) Endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Ephes. 4:3 (NLT) **Always keep yourselves united in the Holy Spirit,**
And **bind** yourselves **together** with **peace.**

2 Peter 1:20-21 (KJV) **Knowing this first, that no Prophecy of the Scripture**
Is of any private interpretation.

[21] **For the Prophecy came not**

In old time by the **will** of man:

But **holy** men of **God** **spoke** as **they were moved** by **the Holy Ghost.**

Ephes. 5:17-18 (NLT) **Don't act thoughtlessly, but try to understand**
What **the Lord wants** you to **do.**

[18] **Don't be** drunk with wine, **because that will ruin** your life.
Instead, **let the Holy Spirit fill and control** you.

1 John 3:24 (NLT) **Those who obey God's commandments**

Live **in fellowship with Him,**

And He with them.

And we know He lives in us because **the Holy Spirit lives in** us.

Ephes. 6:18 (NLT) **Pray at all times and on every occasion**

In the power of the Holy Spirit. Stay **alert** and be **persistent**

In your **prayers** for **all** Christians everywhere.

Ephes. 4:30 (NLT) **And do not bring sorrow to God's Holy Spirit**

By the way you live.

Remember, He is the One who has identified you as **his own,**

Guaranteeing that you **will** be **saved** on the day of **redemption.**

John 20:19-23 (ESV) **On the evening of that day, the first day of the week,**

The doors **being locked** where the disciples were **for fear** of the Jews,

Jesus came and stood among them

And said to them, "**Peace be with you.**"

²⁰ **When He had said this, he showed** them **his hands and his side.**

Then the disciples were **glad** when they **saw the Lord.**

John 3:5-8 (NLT) *Jesus replied, "the Truth is, **No one can enter the Kingdom of God***

Without Being **born** of **water** and **the Spirit**.

[6] Humans **can** reproduce **only** human life,

But **the Holy Spirit gives new life from Heaven**.

[7] **So don't be surprised** at **My statement** that you **must be born again**.

[8] Just as you can **hear** the wind

But **can't tell** where it comes from **or** where it is going,

So you **can't** explain **how** people are **born of the Spirit**."

John 3:5-8 (KJV) *Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto you,*

Except a man be **born** of **water** and **of the Spirit**, **he cannot enter**

Into **the Kingdom of God**.

[6] **That** which is born **of the flesh** is **flesh**;

And **that** which is **born** of **the Spirit** is **spirit**.

[7] **Marvel not that I said unto** you, you **must be born again**.

[8] The wind blows where it listeth, And you **hear** the sound of it, but **can't tell**

Where it comes, **and where** it goes:

So is every one **that** is **born of the Spirit**.

Acts 10:38 (KJV) **How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost**

And with Power:

Who went about doing good,

And healing all that were **oppressed** of the **devil**;

For **God was with Him**.

1 John 4:1-6 (ESV) **Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits**

To **see whether** they are **from God**,

For many false prophets have **gone out into** the world.

² **By this you know the Spirit of God:**

Every spirit **that confesses** that *Jesus Christ has come*

In the flesh is **from God**,

³ And every spirit that **does not** confess *Jesus* is **not** from **God**.

This **is** the **spirit of** the **antichrist**,

Which you heard was **coming** and **now is in** the **world** already.

⁴ Little children, you **are from God** and have **overcome** them,

For **He who is in** you

Is greater than he who **is in** the world.

⁵ They **are from** the world; therefore they **speak from** the world,

And the world **listens to them**.

⁶ We **are from God**. Whoever **knows God listens to us**;

Whoever **is not** from **God** does **not** listen to us.

By this we know the Spirit of Truth and the spirit of **error**.

Ephes. 5:18-20 (KJV) And be **not drunk with wine, wherein is excess;**

But **be filled with the Spirit;**

[19] Speaking to yourselves **in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing**

And **making melody in your heart to the Lord;**

[20] **Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the Name Of our Lord Jesus Christ;**

2 Peter 1:20-21 (NLT) **Above all, you must understand that no prophecy in Scripture**

Ever came from the prophets themselves

[21] **Or** because they **wanted** to prophesy.

It was the Holy Spirit who moved the prophets **to speak from God.**

Galatians 5:16-26 (ESV) **But I say, walk by the Spirit,**

And you **will not gratify the desires of the flesh.**

¹⁷ For the **desires of the flesh are against the Spirit,**

And the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh,

For these **are opposed** to each other,

[39] **This promise is to** you and **to your children, and even to the Gentiles** —

All who have been **called by the Lord** our **God."**

Romans 1:4-5 (NLT) **And Jesus Christ our Lord was shown to be**

The Son of God when God

Powerfully Raised Him from the dead by means of the Holy Spirit.

[34] For He is sent by God, he speaks God's words,

Numbers 11:16-17 (KJV) And the Lord said unto Moses,

[17] And I will come down and talk with you there:

Yet he himself is judged of no man.

[16] For who has known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him?

But we have the mind of Christ.

Acts 2:38-39 (KJV) Then Peter said unto them, repent,

And be baptized every one of you in the Name of Jesus Christ

For the forgiveness of sins,

And you shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

[39] For the promise is unto you, and to your children and to all that are afar off,

Even as many as the Lord our God shall call.

John 14:16-18 (KJV) And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you
Another Comforter,

That He may abide with you forever;

He alone decides which gift each person should **have**.
