Through all the meaningless days of life

That God has given you in this world.

The wife **God gives** you **is** your **reward for** all your earthly **toil**.

Eccles. 9:9 (KJV) Live joyfully with the wife whom you love

All the days of the life of your vanity (having no real value),

Which He has given you under the sun, all the days of your vanity:

For that is your portion in this life,

And **in** your **labor** which you take under the sun.

Col. 3:19 (KJV) Husbands, love your wives, and be not bitter against them.

He gave up his life for her

- [26] To make her (the church) holy and clean, washed by baptism and God's Word.
- [27] He did this to present her (the church) to himself

As a glorious church without a spot or wrinkle or any other blemish.

Instead, she will be holy and without fault.

- [28] In the <u>same</u> way, husbands <u>ought</u> to <u>love</u> their wives as they <u>love</u> their own bodies.
 - For a man **is** actually **loving** himself **when** he **loves** his wife.
- [29] No one hates his own body but lovingly cares for it,

Just as Christ cares for his body, which is the church.

- Ephes. 5:23 (NLT) For a husband is the head of his wife

 As Christ is the head of his body the church;

 He gave his life to be her Savior.

But a woman who fears the Lord is to be praised.

- Give her of the fruit of her hands, and let her works praise her in the gates.
- 1 Cor. 7:2 (KJV) Nevertheless, to avoid fornication,

Let every man have his own wife,

And let every woman have her own husband.

Luke 16:18 (KJV) Whosoever puts <u>away</u> his wife, And marries another

Commits adultery:

And whosoever marries her **that** is **put away** from her husband **Commits adultery**.

Proverbs 19:13-14 (KJV) A foolish son is the calamity of his father:

And the **contentions** of a wife are a continual dropping.

[14] House and riches **are** the inheritance of fathers

- [34] For the woman's husband will be <u>furious</u> in his **jealousy**,

 And he will have no mercy in his day of vengeance.
- [35] There **is no** compensation or bribe **that** will satisfy him.
- Romans 7:2 (NLT) Let me <u>illustrate</u>. When a woman marries,

 The law <u>binds</u> her to her husband as long as he is alive.

 But if he dies, the laws of marriage no longer apply to her.
- Romans 7:2 (KJV) For the woman which has a husband

But a woman that fears the Lord, she shall be praised.

[31] Give her of the fruit of her hands; And let her own works praise her in the gates.

And slept with her. She became pregnant and gave birth to a son,

And they **named** him Solomon. The Lord loved the child

- [2] By watching your pure, godly behavior.
- [3] **Don't** be concerned about the outward beauty that depends on fancy hairstyles, Expensive jewelry, or beautiful clothes.

The unfading beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit,

Ephesians 5:23-27 (ESV) For the husband is the head of the wife

<u>Even as Christ</u> is the <u>head of</u> the church, <u>his body</u>, And is Himself its Savior.

Now as the church submits to Christ,

So also wives should submit in everything to their husbands.

²⁵ Husbands, <u>love</u> your wives, <u>as <u>Christ loved</u> the church <u>and gave <u>himself</u> <u>up</u> for her,</u></u>

²⁶ That He might sanctify her, having cleansed her

By the washing of water with the Word,

²⁷ So that He might present the church to himself in splendor,

Without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy And without blemish.

²⁸ In the <u>same</u> way husbands should <u>love</u> their wives as their own bodies.

He who **loves** his wife **loves** himself.

For **no one** ever **hated** his own flesh, but **nourishes** and **cherishes** it, **Just as Christ does** the **church**,

Because we are members of <u>His</u> <u>body</u>.

- Therefore a man **shall leave** his father and mother and **hold <u>fast</u>** to his wife, And the **two** shall **become one** flesh."
- ³² This mystery is profound, and I am saying that it refers to *Christ* and the church.

However, let each one of you <u>love</u> his wife <u>as</u> himself,

And let the wife see that she respects her husband.

1 Cor. 7:10-11 (KJV) And unto the married I command, yet not I, but the Lord,

Let <u>not</u> the wife depart from her husband:

- [11] But and **if** she **depart**, let her **remain unmarried**, or **be reconciled** to her husband: And **let not** the husband **put away** his wife.
- 1 Corinthians 7:10-16 (ESV) **To the married I give this charge (not I, <u>but the Lord</u>):**The wife **should <u>not</u>** separate from her husband
- 11 (But **if** she **does**, she **should remain** unmarried **or else be <u>reconciled</u>** to her husband), And the husband **should <u>not</u>** divorce his wife.

¹² To the rest I say (I, **not** the Lord)

That if any brother has a wife who is an unbeliever,

And she **consents** to live **with** him, he **should not** divorce her.

- 13 If any woman has a husband who is an <u>unbeliever</u>, and he consents to live with her,

 She should <u>not</u> divorce him.
- ¹⁴ For the <u>unbelieving</u> husband is **made** <u>holy</u> because <u>of</u> his wife,

And the **unbelieving** wife is **made holy** because **of** her husband.

Otherwise your children would be unclean, but as it is, they are holy.

But if the <u>unbelieving</u> partner <u>separates</u>, let it be so.

In such cases the brother or sister is not enslaved.

God has called you to peace.

For **how** do you **know**, wife, **whether** you will **save** your husband?

Or **how** do you **know**, husband, **whether** you will **save** your wife?

The army of Persia and Media

And the nobles and governors of the provinces were before him,

⁴ While he showed the riches of his royal glory and the splendor

And pomp of his greatness for many days, 180 days.

⁵ And when these days were completed,

The king **gave for all** the people present in Susa, the citadel,

Both great and small, a **feast**

But Queen Vashti <u>refused</u> to come at the king's command delivered by the eunuchs.

At this the king **became enraged**, and his **anger burned** within him.

Then the king said to the wise men who knew the times

(for **this was** the king's procedure

Toward all who were versed in law and judgment,

¹⁴ The men next to him being Carshena, Shethar, Admatha, Tarshish, Meres, Marsena, And Memucan, the seven princes of Persia and Media,

Who saw the king's face, and sat first in the kingdom):

15 "According to the law, what is to be done to Queen Vashti,

Because she **has** <u>not</u> performed the **command of** King Ahasuerus **Delivered by** the eunuchs?"

¹⁶ Then Memucan said in the presence of the king and the officials,

"Not only <u>against</u> the king has Queen Vashti done wrong, but also Against all the officials and all the peoples

Who are in all the provinces of King Ahasuerus. (Story continued on pg39v)

Esther 1:17-22 (ESV) (Continuation from page 39u) For the queen's behavior

⁶ Then the Spirit of the Lord rushed upon him,

And although he had nothing in his hand,

He tore the lion in pieces as one tears a young goat.

But he did not tell his father or his mother what he had done.

⁷ Then he went down and talked with the woman, and she was right in Samson's eyes.

⁸ After some days he returned to take her.

Judges 14:16-20 (ESV) (Story continuation from 39w) And Samson's wife wept over him

And said, "You only hate me; you do not love me.

You have put a riddle to my people,

And you have not told me what it is." And he said to her,

"Behold, I have not told my father nor my mother,

And shall I tell you?"

¹⁷ She wept before him the seven days that their feast lasted,

And on the seventh day he told her, because she <u>pressed</u> him <u>hard</u>.

Then she told the riddle to her people.

¹⁸ And the men of the city said to him on the seventh day before the sun went down,

"What is sweeter than honey? What is stronger than a lion?"

And he said to them, "If you had not plowed with my heifer,

³ And Samson said to them, "This time I shall be innocent in regard to the Philistines, When I do them harm."

⁴ So Samson went and caught 300 foxes and took torches. And he turned them Tail to tail and put a torch between each pair of tails.

⁵ And when he had set fire to the torches,

He **let** the **foxes** go **into** the standing grain of the Philistines And **set fire** to the stacked **grain** and the standing grain,

As well as the olive orchards.

⁶ Then the Philistines said, "Who has done this?" And they said, "Samson,

The son-in-law of the Timnite, because he has taken his wife

To do to him as he did to us."

¹¹ Then 3,000 men of Judah went down to the cleft of the rock of Etam,

And said to Samson,

"Do you **not know** that the Philistines **are rulers** over us?

What then is this that you have done to us?"

And he said to them, "As they did to me, so have I done to them."

¹² And they said to him, "We have come down to bind you,

That we may give you into the hands of the Philistines."

Luke 11:17 (NLT) <u>He</u> <u>knew</u> their thoughts, <u>so</u> <u>he</u> <u>said</u>,

1 Corinthians 7:25-40 (ESV) Now concerning the betrothed,

I have no command from the Lord, but I give my judgment

As one who by the Lord's mercy is trustworthy.

²⁶ I think that in view of the present distress it is good for a person to remain as he is.

²⁷ Are you bound to a wife? Do <u>not</u> seek to be free. Are you free from a wife?

Do not seek a wife.

- But if you do marry, you have not sinned, and if a betrothed woman marries,

 She has not sinned. Yet those who marry will have worldly troubles,

 And I would spare you that.
- ²⁹ This is what I mean, brothers: the appointed time has grown very short.

From now on, let those who have wives

Live as though they had none,

³⁰ And those who **mourn** as though they **were not** mourning,

And those who rejoice as though they were not rejoicing,

And those who buy as though they had no goods,

³¹ And those who deal with the world as though they had no dealings with it.

For the **present form** of this world is **passing away**.

³² I want you to be free from anxieties. The unmarried man is anxious

About the things of the Lord, how to please the Lord.

But the married man is anxious about worldly things, how to please his wife,

- And his interests are divided. And the unmarried or betrothed woman is anxious

 About the things of the Lord, how to be holy in body and Spirit.

 But the married woman is anxious about worldly things,

 How to please her husband.
- ³⁵ I say this for your own benefit, not to lay any restraint upon you,

But to promote good order

And to secure your undivided devotion to the Lord.

³⁶ If anyone thinks that he is not behaving properly toward his betrothed,

If his passions are strong, and it has to be,

Let him do as he wishes: let them marry---it is no sin.

37 But whoever is **firmly established** in his heart, being under **no necessity**

But having his desire under control,

And has determined this in his heart, to keep her as his betrothed, He will do well.

³⁸ So then he who marries his betrothed does well,

And he who refrains from marriage will do even better.

- A wife **is bound** to her husband **as long as** he **lives**. But **if** her husband **dies**, She **is free** to be married **to** whom she **wishes**, only **in** the Lord.
- 40 Yet in my judgment she is happier if she remains as she is.

And I think that I too have the Spirit of God.

Page # 39ba / What is God's will in marriage?

1 Cor. 7:25-40 (NLT) Now, about the young women who are not yet married.

I do not have a command from the Lord for them.

But the Lord in his kindness has given me wisdom that can be trusted, And I will share it with you.

- [26] Because of the present crisis, I think it is best to remain just as you are.
- [27] If you have a wife, do not end the marriage. If you do not have a wife, Do not get married.
- [28] But **if** you **do get** married, **it is not** a sin. And **if** a young woman **gets married**, **It is not** a sin. However,

I am trying to spare you the extra problems that come with marriage.

[29] Now let me say this, dear brothers and sisters:

The time that remains is very short,

So husbands should not let marriage be their major concern.

- [30] Happiness or sadness or wealth should <u>not</u> keep anyone from doing <u>God's</u> work.
- [31] Those in frequent contact with the things of the world

Should make good use of them without becoming attached to them, For this world and all it contains will pass away.

[32] In everything you do,

I want you to be free from the concerns of this life.

An **unmarried** man **can spend** his time **doing the Lord's work** And **thinking** how to **please Him.**

[33] But a married man can't do that so well. He has to think about

His earthly **responsibilities** and **how to please** his wife.

[34] His **interests are divided.** In the same way,

A woman who is no longer married or has never been married

Can be more devoted to the Lord in body and in Spirit,

While the married woman must be concerned

About her earthly responsibilities and how to please her husband.

[35] I am saying this for your benefit,

Not to place restrictions on you.

I want you to do whatever will help you serve the Lord best,

With as few distractions as possible.

[36] But if a man thinks he ought to marry his fiancée

Because he has trouble controlling his passions and time is passing, It is all right; it is not a sin. Let them marry.

[37] But **if** he **has decided** firmly **not to** marry and **there is** no urgency

And he **can control** his passion, he does well not to marry.

[38] So the person who marries does well,

And the person who doesn't marry does even better.

[39] A wife is married to her husband as long as he lives. If her husband dies,

She is free to marry whomever she wishes,

But this **must be** a marriage **acceptable** to the Lord.

[40] But in my opinion it will be better for her if she doesn't marry again,

And I think I am giving you counsel from God's Spirit when I say this.

Page # 39bb / What is God's will in marriage?

1 Cor. 7:27-29 (KJV) Are you bound unto a wife? seek not to be loosed.

Are you **released** from a wife? **seek not** a wife.

[28] But and if you marry, you have not sinned; and if a virgin marry,

She **has not** sinned. Nevertheless such **shall have trouble** in the **flesh:** But I **spare** you.

[29] But this I say, brethren, the **time is short:** it remains,

That both they that have wives be as though they had none;

Luke 11:17 (KJV) But He, knowing their thoughts, said unto them,

Every kingdom <u>divided</u> against <u>itself</u> is <u>brought</u> to <u>desolation</u>; And a <u>house divided against</u> a house <u>falls</u>.

Luke 11:17 (ESV) But He, knowing their thoughts, said to them,

"Every kingdom divided <u>against</u> itself is <u>laid waste</u>, And <u>a divided household falls</u>.

1 Kings 21:25-29 (NLT) No one else so completely sold himself

To what was evil in the Lord's sight

As did Ahab,

For his wife, Jezebel, influenced him.

[26] He was especially guilty

Because he worshiped idols just as the Amorites had done—
The people whom the Lord had driven from the land
Ahead of the Israelites.

[27] When Ahab heard this message,

He tore his clothing, dressed in sackcloth,

And fasted.

He even slept in sackcloth and went about in deep mourning.

[28] Then another message from the Lord came to Elijah,

Who was from Tishbe:

[29] "Do you see how Ahab has **humbled** himself **before** Me?

Because he has done this,

I will not do what I promised during his lifetime.

It will happen to his sons;

I will destroy all his descendants."
