Romans 10:16-17 (NLT) **But not everyone welcomes the Good News,**

For Isaiah the prophet said,

"**Lord, who has believed our message?**"

[17] **Yet faith comes from listening to this message of Good News—  
The Good News about Christ.**

John 7:16-17 (KJV) **Jesus answered them, and said,**

**My doctrine is not mine, but His that sent me.**

[17] **If any man will do His will, He shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God,  
Or whether I speak of myself.**

Proverbs 8:17 (KJV) **I love them that love me;**

And those that **seek me** early shall **find me.**

Proverbs 16:3 (KJV) **Commit your works unto the Lord,**

**And your thoughts shall be established.**

Romans 10:11 (KJV) **For the Scripture says,**

**Whosoever believes on Him shall not be ashamed.**

Romans 12:2 (KJV) **And be not conformed to this world:**

But you **need to be transformed by the renewing of your mind,**

That you may prove

What is that **good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.**

Luke 17:5-10 (NLT) **One day the apostles said to the Lord, "we need more faith;**

**Tell us how to get it."**

[6] **"Even if you had faith as small as a mustard seed,"**

**The Lord answered, "You could say to this mulberry tree,**

**'May God uproot you and throw you into the sea,'**

**And it would obey you!**

[7] **"When a servant comes in from plowing or taking care of sheep,**

He **doesn't** just sit down and eat.

[8] He **must first** prepare his master's meal **and serve** him his supper

**Before eating his own.**

[9] And the servant is **not even** thanked,

Because he is merely **doing** what **he is supposed to do.**

[10] In the **same** way, **when** you **obey Me** you should say,

**"We are not** worthy of praise.

We are **servants** who **have simply done our duty."**

Hebrews 11:6 (KJV) **But without faith it is impossible to please Him:**

For he that **comes to God** must believe that **he is,**

And that **He is a rewarder** of them **that diligently seek him.**

## Page # 6b / How do I get faith?

1 Chron. 28:9 (KJV) **And you, Solomon my son, know the God of your father,  
And serve Him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind:  
For the Lord searches all hearts,  
And understands all the imaginations of the thoughts:  
If you seek Him, he will be found of you;  
But if you forsake Him, he will cast you off forever.**

Romans 10:14-17 (KJV) **How then shall they call on Him  
In Whom they have not believed?  
And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard?  
And how shall they hear without a preacher?  
[15] And how shall they preach, except they are sent? As it is Written,  
How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the Gospel of Peace,  
And bring glad tidings of Good Things!  
[16] But they have not all obeyed the Gospel.  
For Esaias saith, Lord, who has believed our report?  
[17] So then faith comes by hearing,  
And hearing by the word of God.**

Romans 10:14-17 (NLT) **But how can they call on Him to save them  
Unless they believe in Him?  
And how can they believe in Him  
If they have never heard about Him?  
And how can they hear about Him unless someone tells them?  
[15] And how will anyone go and tell them without being sent?  
That is what the Scriptures mean when they say,  
"How beautiful are the feet of those who bring Good News (God's word)!"  
[16] But not everyone welcomes the Good News,  
For Isaiah the prophet said, "Lord, who has believed our message?"  
[17] Yet faith comes from listening to this message of Good News —  
The Good News about Christ.**

1 Chron. 28:9 (NLT) **"And Solomon, my son, get to know the God of your ancestors.  
Worship and serve Him with your whole heart  
And with a willing mind.  
For the Lord sees every heart  
And understands and knows every plan and thought.  
If you seek Him, you will find him.  
But if you forsake Him, he will reject you forever.**

Hebrews 11:6 (NLT) **So, you see, it is impossible to please God without faith.  
Anyone who wants to come to Him  
Must believe that there is a God  
And that He rewards those who sincerely seek him.**

## Page # 6c / How do I get faith?

Romans 1:16-17 (NLT) For I am **not** ashamed of **this Good News about Christ.**

**It is the power of God at work,**

**Saving everyone who believes**—Jews first and also Gentiles.

[17] **This Good News tells** us how **God makes** us **right in his sight.**

This is accomplished **from start to finish by faith.**

**As the Scriptures say,”**

**It is through faith** that a **righteous** person has **life.”**

Romans 1:16-17 (KJV) For I am **not** ashamed of **the Gospel of Christ:**

**For it is the power of God unto salvation**

**To every one that believes;** To the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

[17] **For in this the righteousness of God is revealed** from **faith** to **faith:**

**As it is Written, the just shall live by faith.**

James 4:8 (NLT) **Draw close to God, and God will draw close to you.**

**Wash** your hands, you **sinners;** **purify** your hearts, you **hypocrites.**

Proverbs 2:1-15 (ESV) My son, **if you receive My words**

And **treasure up My commandments with** you,

<sup>2</sup> **Making** your ear **attentive to wisdom** and **inclining** your heart **to understanding;**

<sup>3</sup> **Yes, if you call out for insight** and **raise** your voice **for understanding,**

<sup>4</sup> **If you seek it like silver** and **search for it as for hidden treasures,**

<sup>5</sup> **Then** you will **understand the fear of the Lord** and **find the knowledge of God.**

<sup>6</sup> **For the Lord gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding;**

<sup>7</sup> **He stores up sound wisdom for** the upright;

**He is a shield to** those **who walk in integrity,**

<sup>8</sup> **Guarding** the **paths of justice** and **watching over** the way of **His saints.**

<sup>9</sup> **Then you will understand righteousness**

And **justice** and **equity,** every **good** path;

<sup>10</sup> **For wisdom will come into** your heart, **and knowledge will be pleasant to your soul;**

<sup>11</sup> **Discretion** will watch **over** you, **understanding** will **guard** you,

<sup>12</sup> **Delivering you from** the way of **evil,** from men of **perverted** speech,

<sup>13</sup> Who **forsake** the paths of uprightness to **walk in** the ways of **darkness,**

<sup>14</sup> Who rejoice in **doing evil** and delight **in** the **perverseness** of **evil,**

<sup>15</sup> Men whose paths are **crooked,** and **who are devious** in their **ways.**

Deut. 8:2-3 (NLT) Remember how **the Lord your God**

**Led** you **through** the wilderness for forty years,

Humbling you **and testing** you to **prove** your **character,**

**And to find out** whether or not **you would really obey His commands.**

[3] Yes, **He humbled** you **by letting** you go hungry **and then feeding** you with **manna,**

A food **previously unknown** to you and your ancestors.

**He did it to teach** you that people **need more than bread for their life;**

**Real life comes** by **feeding** on **every word of the Lord.**

## Page # 6d / How do I get faith?

1 Thes. 2:13 (NLT) **And we will never stop thanking God**

That when we **preached His message** to you,  
You didn't think of **the Words** we **spoke** as **being** just our own.  
You **accepted** what we said **as the very word of God—**  
Which, of course, **it was.**  
**And this Word continues to work** in you who **believe.**

Psalm 27:14 (KJV) **Wait on the Lord: Be of good courage,**

**And He shall strengthen** your heart: **wait,** I say, **on the Lord.**

Romans 10:11 (NLT) **As the Scriptures tell us,**

"Anyone who **believes** in **Him** **will not** be disappointed."

James 4:7-8 (KJV) **Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil,**

And he **will flee** from you.

[8] Draw **close** to **God, and he will draw close to** you. **Cleanse** your hands, you **sinners;**  
**And purify your hearts,** you **double** minded.

Proverbs 8:17 (KJV) **I love them that love me;**

And those that **seek Me** early **shall find me.**

Proverbs 22:17-21 (KJV) **Bow down your ear, and hear the Words of the wise,**

And **apply** your heart **unto My knowledge.**

[18] For it is a pleasant thing **if** you **keep them** within yourself;

**They shall** withal (despite anything to the contrary) be **fitted** in your lips.

[19] That your **trust** may be **in the Lord,**

**I have made known to** you this day, even to you.

[20] Haven't **I written to** you **excellent things in counsels and knowledge,**

[21] **That I might make** you know **the certainty of the words of Truth;**

That you might **answer** the **words of Truth**

To them that **send for** you?

Proverbs 22:17-21 (NLT) **Listen to the Words of the wise;**

**Apply** your heart **to My instruction.**

[18] **For it is good to keep these sayings** deep **within** yourself,

**Always ready** on your lips.

[19] **I am teaching** you today—**yes,** you— **So you will trust in the Lord.**

[20] **I have written thirty sayings** for you, **filled with advice and knowledge.**

[21] In this way, **you may know the Truth**

And **bring an accurate report** to those who **sent** you.

Mark 8:35 (NLT) **If you try to keep your life for yourself, you will lose it.**

**But** if you **give up** your life **for My sake**

And **for the sake of the Good News,** you will **find true life.**

Deut. 8:2-3 (KJV) **And you shall remember all the way which the Lord your God Led** you these forty years in the wilderness,  
**To humble** you, **and to prove** you, **to know** what was in your heart,  
**Whether** you would keep **His commandments**, or **not**.

[3] **And He humbled** you, **and suffered** you to **hunger**, **and fed** you with **manna**,  
Which you knew not, neither did your fathers know;  
That **He might make** you **know**  
That **man does not live** by bread only, **but by every Word that proceeds**  
**Out of the mouth of the Lord** **does man live**.

Joshua 1:8-9 (NLT) **Study this Book of the Law continually.**

**Meditate** on **it** day and night **so you may be sure to obey**  
**All that is Written in it**. **Only then** will you **succeed**.

[9] **I command** you—be **strong** and **courageous**! Do **not** be afraid or discouraged.  
**For the Lord** your **God is with** you **wherever you go**."

Joshua 1:8-9 (KJV) **This book of the law shall not depart out of your mouth;**

But you shall **meditate inside it** day and night,  
**That you will observe to do** according **to all that is Written inside it**:  
For **then** you shall **make** your way **prosperous**,  
And **then** you shall **have** good **success**.

Psalms 9:9-10 (NLT) **The Lord is a shelter** for the oppressed,

**A refuge** in times of **trouble**.

[10] **Those who know Your name trust in you, for you, O Lord,**  
**Have never** abandoned anyone who searches **for You**.

John 3:31-36 (ESV) **He who comes from above is above** all.

He who **is of** the earth **belongs to** the earth  
And speaks **in** an **earthly** way.

**He who comes from Heaven is above** all.

<sup>32</sup> **He bears witness to what he has seen and heard**, yet **no** one receives **his testimony**.

<sup>33</sup> **Whoever receives His testimony** sets his seal to **this**, that **God is true**.

<sup>34</sup> **For He whom God has sent utters the words of God,**  
**For He gives the Spirit without** measure.

<sup>35</sup> **The Father loves the Son and has given all** things **into his hand**.

<sup>36</sup> **Whoever believes in the Son** has **eternal life**; whoever **does not** obey **the Son**  
**Shall not** see life, **but the wrath of God remains on** him.

**For it is the power of God for salvation to** everyone who **believes**,  
To the Jew first **and also** to the Greek.

<sup>17</sup> **For in it the righteousness of God is revealed** from **faith** for **faith, as it is written**,  
"The **righteous shall live by faith**."

Matthew 7:7-11(KJV) **Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and you shall find;**  
**Knock, and it shall be opened** unto you:

[8] **For every one that asks receives;**

And he that **seeks finds**; And to him that **knocks** it shall be **opened**.

[9] Or **what man is there** of you, whom **if** his son **ask** bread,

Will he **give** him a **stone**?

[10] Or **if** he **ask** a fish, will he **give** him a **serpent**?

[11] If you then, **being evil**, **know how to give good** gifts unto your children,

How much more **shall** your **Father**

**Which is in Heaven give good things** to them that **ask Him**?

2 Kings 5:13-14 (NLT) **But his officers tried to reason with him and said,**

"Sir, **if** the prophet **had told** you **to do some great thing**,

Wouldn't you have **done it**?

**So you should** certainly **obey** him

When he **says simply to go and wash** and be **cured!**"

[14] So Naaman went down to the Jordan River and **dipped himself seven times**,

**As the man of God** had **instructed** him.

And his flesh became as **healthy** as a young child's,

And he was **healed!**

2 Kings 5:13-14 (KJV) **And his servants came near, and spoke unto him,**

And said, My father, **if** the prophet **had bid** you **do some great thing**,

**Wouldn't** you have **done it**?

**How much** rather then, when he **says to you, wash**, and be **clean**?

[14] **Then** went he **down**, and **dipped** himself seven times in Jordan,

**According to the saying of** the man **of God**:

And his flesh **came** again **like** unto the flesh of a little child,

And he was **clean**.

Romans 12:1-3 (ESV) **I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God,**

**To present** your bodies **as** a living sacrifice,

**Holy** and acceptable **to God**, **which is your spiritual worship**.

<sup>2</sup> Do **not** be conformed to **this** world, but **be transformed** by the **renewal** of your mind,

**That by testing** you may **discern** what is the **will of God**,

What is **good** and **acceptable** and **perfect**.

<sup>3</sup> **For by the grace given to** me I say to everyone among you

**Not to think of himself more** highly than he ought to think,

But to think **with** sober judgment,

Each **according to** the measure of **faith** that **God has assigned**.

Acts 4:4 (NLT) **But many of the people who heard their message** (God's word)

**Believed it**, so that the number of **believers** totaled

About five thousand men, **not counting** women and children.

## Page # 6g / How do I get faith?

John 14:19-21 (NLT) In just a little while **the world will not see Me** again,

But you **will**. For I will live again, and you **will, too**.

When I am raised to life again, you will know

That I am in my Father, and you are **in me**,

And I am in you.

[21] Those who **obey My commandments** are the ones who **love me**.

And because they **love Me, my Father will love** them,

And I will love them. And I will reveal myself to each one of them."

Proverbs 2:1-10 (NLT) My child, **listen to Me** and **treasure my instructions**.

[2] **Tune** your ears to **wisdom**, and **concentrate on understanding**.

[3] **Cry out** for **insight** and **understanding**.

[4] **Search** for **them** as you would for lost money or hidden **treasure**.

[5] Then you will **understand** **what it means to fear the Lord**,

And you will **gain knowledge of God**.

[6] **For the Lord grants wisdom!**

From His mouth comes knowledge and understanding.

[7] **He grants a treasure** of **good sense** to the **godly**.

He is their **shield, protecting** those who walk **with integrity**.

[8] **He guards the paths of justice**

And protects those who are **faithful** to **Him**.

[9] **Then** you will **understand** what is **right, just, and fair**,

And you **will know** how to **find the right course of action** every time.

[10] **For wisdom will enter** your heart,

And knowledge will fill you with **joy**.

Proverbs 2:1-6 (KJV) My son, **if you will receive My words**,

And hide **My commandments with** you;

[2] So that you **incline** your ear **unto wisdom**, and **apply your heart to understanding**;

[3] Yes, if you **cry after knowledge**,

And **lift up your voice for understanding**;

[4] **If you seek her as silver**, And **search for her as for hidden treasures**;

[5] **Then shall you understand the fear of the Lord**, and **find the knowledge of God**.

[6] **For the Lord gives wisdom:**

Out of His mouth comes knowledge and understanding.

John 14:19-21 (KJV) **Yet a little while, and the world sees Me no more;**

But you **see Me: Because I live**, you shall **live** also.

At that day you shall **know** that I am in my Father,

And you **in Me, and I in** you.

[21] **He that has My commandments**, and **keeps them**, **he it is that loves me:**

And he that **loves Me shall be loved of my Father**,

And I will love him,

And will manifest Myself to him.

## Page # 6h / How do I get faith?

James 1:22-25 (NLT) **And remember, It is a message to obey, not just to listen to.**

If you **don't obey**, you are only **fooling** yourself.

[23] **For if you just listen** and **don't** obey,

It is **like** looking at your face in a mirror

But **doing nothing** to improve your appearance.

[24] You see yourself, walk **away**, and **forget what** you look like.

[25] But **if** you keep **looking** steadily **into God's perfect law** —

**The law** that **sets** you **free**—**And if you do what it says**

And **don't** forget **what** you **heard**, **then God will bless** you for **doing it**.

James 4:8 (KJV) **Draw close to God, and he will draw close to you.**

**Cleanse** your hands, you **sinner**;

**And purify** your hearts, you **double** minded.

John 3:31-35 (NLT) "**He has come from above and is greater than** anyone else.

I am of the earth, and my understanding is **limited** to the **things of** earth,

**But He has come from Heaven.**

[32] **He tells what he has seen and heard**, but **how few** believe **what he tells** them!

[33] **Those who believe Him discover that God is true** (Truth).

[34] **For He is sent by God. He speaks God's words,**

**For God's Spirit is upon Him without** measure or limit.

[35] **The Father loves his Son,**

**And He has given Him Authority over** everything.

John 3:31-35 (KJV) **He that comes from above is above all:**

He that is of the earth is **earthly**, and **speaks of** the earth:

**He that comes from Heaven is above** all.

[32] **And what He has seen and heard,**

**That He testifies;** and **no** man receives **his testimony.**

[33] **He that has received His testimony** has set to his **seal** that **God is true** (Truth).

[34] **For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God:**

**For God gives not the Spirit** by measure **unto Him.**

[35] **The Father loves the Son,**

**And has given all things into His hand.**

Psalms 19:7-11 (ESV) **The law of the Lord is perfect, reviving the soul;**

**The testimony of the Lord is sure, making** wise the simple;

<sup>8</sup> **The precepts of the Lord are right, rejoicing** the heart;

**The commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening** the eyes;

<sup>9</sup> The **fear** of **the Lord** is **clean**, enduring **forever**;

**The rules of the Lord are true, and righteous altogether.**

<sup>10</sup> **More** to be **desired** are **they** than gold, **even** much fine gold;

**Sweeter also** than honey and drippings of the honeycomb.

<sup>11</sup> Moreover, **by them** is your servant **warned**; in keeping **them** there is **great reward.**

James 1:22-25 (KJV) **But be you doers of the Word, and not hearers only, Deceiving** your own selves.

[23] For **if any** be a **hearer of the Word**, and **not** a **doer**,  
He is **like unto** a man **beholding** his natural face **in a glass**:

[24] **For he beholds himself**, and goes his **way**,  
And straightway **forgets what manner of man he was**.

[25] But whoever **looks** into **the perfect law of liberty**,  
**And continues in this**, he being **not** a forgetful hearer,  
But a **doer** of the **work**, this man **shall be blessed** in his **deed**.

Proverbs 8:17 (NLT) **"I love all who love me.**  
**Those who search for Me** will surely **find me**.

Psalms 19:7-11 (KJV) **The law of the Lord is perfect, converting the soul:**  
The **testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise** the simple.

[8] **The statutes of the Lord are right,**  
**Rejoicing** the heart:

[9] The **fear** of **the Lord** is **clean**, enduring **forever**:  
**The judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether.**

[10] **More** to be **desired** **are they** than gold,  
**Yes**, than much fine gold:  
**Sweeter also** than honey and the honeycomb.

[11] **Moreover by them is** your servant **warned**:  
And **in** keeping **of them** there is great **reward**.

Psalms 19:7-11 (NLT) **The law of the Lord is perfect, reviving the soul.**  
**The decrees of the Lord are trustworthy,**  
**Making wise** the simple.

[8] **The commandments of the Lord are right,**  
**Bringing joy** to the heart.  
**The commands of the Lord are clear, giving insight** to life.

[9] **Reverence** for **the Lord** is **pure**, lasting **forever**.  
**The laws of the Lord are true; each one is fair.**

[10] **They are more desirable** than **gold**, even the finest **gold**.  
**They are sweeter** than honey, **even** honey dripping from the comb.

[11] **They are a warning to** those who **hear them**:  
There is **great reward** for those who **obey them**.

1 Thessalonians 2:3 (ESV) **And we also thank God** constantly for **this**,  
That when you **received the word of God**,  
which you **heard from** us,  
You accepted **it not as the word of men** but as **what it really is**,  
**The word of God, which is at work in** you **believers**.

## Page # 6j / How do I get faith?

John 4:40-42 (KJV) So when the Samaritans were come unto **Him**,

They **besought Him** that **he would stay** with them:

**And He abode there** two days.

[41] **And many more believed because of His own word;**

[42] And said unto the woman, **now we believe, not** because of your **saying:**

For we have **heard Him** ourselves,

And **know** that **this is indeed the Christ, the Savior of** the world.

John 4:40-42 (NLT) **When they came out to see Him,**

They **begged Him** to stay at their village. **So he stayed for** two days,

[41] Long enough for many of them to **hear His message and believe.**

[42] Then they said to the woman,

"Now we **believe because we have heard Him** ourselves,

**Not just** because of what you **told** us.

**He is indeed the Savior of** the world."

Isaiah 7:9 (ESV) **And the head of Ephraim is Samaria,**

And the head of Samaria is the son of Remaliah.

**If you are not firm in faith, you will not be firm at all."**

Isaiah 7:9 (KJV) **And the head of Ephraim is Samaria,**

And the head of Samaria is Remaliah's son.

**If you will not believe,** surely you **shall not** be established.

James 4:4-10 (ESV) **You adulterous people! Do you not know**

That friendship **with** the world is **enmity** (hostility) **with God?**

Therefore whoever **wishes to be** a friend **of** the world

**Makes** himself an **enemy of God.**

<sup>5</sup> Or **do you suppose** it is to no purpose that **the Scripture says,**

**"He yearns jealously over** the **Spirit** that **he has made to dwell in us"**?

<sup>6</sup> **But He gives more grace. Therefore it says,**

**"God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble."**

<sup>7</sup> **Submit** yourselves therefore **to God.**

**Resist the devil,** and **he will flee** from you.

<sup>8</sup> Draw near **to God, and he will draw near to** you. **Cleanse** your hands, you sinners,

And **purify** your hearts, you **double-minded.**

<sup>9</sup> **Be wretched and mourn and weep.** Let your laughter be **turned to mourning**

And your **joy to gloom.**

<sup>10</sup> **Humble** yourselves **before the Lord, and he will exalt** you.

Isaiah 7:9 (NLT) **Israel is no stronger than its capital, Samaria.**

And Samaria **is no stronger than** its king, Pekah son of Remaliah.

You **do not** believe **Me? If you want me to protect** you,

**Learn to believe what I say."**

## Page # 6k / How do I get faith?

Romans 10:6-18 (ESV) **But the righteousness based on faith says,**

"Do **not** say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into Heaven?'"

(That is, to bring Christ down)

<sup>7</sup> **Or** "'Who will descend into the abyss?'" (That is, to bring Christ up from the dead).

<sup>8</sup> **But what does it say?** "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart"

(That is, the word of faith that we **proclaim**);

<sup>9</sup> Because, **if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord**

And **believe in** your heart **that God raised Him from the dead,**

You will be saved.

<sup>10</sup> For **with** the heart **one believes and is justified,**

And **with** the mouth one **confesses** and is **saved.**

<sup>11</sup> **For the Scripture says,** "Everyone who believes **in Him will not** be put to shame."

<sup>12</sup> For there is **no** distinction **between** Jew and Greek; **for the same Lord is Lord of** all,

**Bestowing His riches on** all **who call on him.**

<sup>13</sup> For "everyone who calls **on the name of the Lord** will be **saved.**"

<sup>14</sup> **How then** will they **call on Him in whom** they have **not** believed?

And **how** are they to believe **in Him of whom** they have **never** heard?

**And how are they to hear** without someone **preaching?**

<sup>15</sup> And **how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is Written,**

"How beautiful **are** the feet of those who **preach the Good News!**"

<sup>16</sup> But they **have not** all obeyed **the Gospel.** For Isaiah says, "**Lord, who has believed**

**What he has heard from us** (Isaiah speaking God's word) ?"

<sup>17</sup> **So faith comes from hearing,** and hearing **through the word of Christ.**

<sup>18</sup> But I **ask,** have they **not** heard? **Indeed they have,**

For "Their **voice** has **gone out** to all the earth,

And their **Words** (God's word) **to the ends of** the world."

John 7:16-18 (ESV) **So Jesus answered them, "My teaching is not mine,**

**But His who sent Me.**

<sup>17</sup> **If anyone's will is to do God's will,** he will know whether **the teaching is from God**

**Or whether I am speaking on my own** authority.

<sup>18</sup> The one who **speaks on his own** authority **seeks** his **own** glory;

**But the One who seeks the glory of Him**

**Who sent Him is true, and in him there is no** falsehood.

Matthew 7:8-11 (ESV) "Ask, and it will be given to you; **seek, and you will find;**

**Knock, and it will be opened to you.**

<sup>8</sup> For everyone who **asks receives,** and the one who **seeks finds,**

And to the one who **knocks** it will be **opened.**

<sup>9</sup> Or **which one** of you, **if his son asks him for bread,** **will give him a stone?**

<sup>10</sup> Or **if he asks for a fish,** **will give him a serpent?**

## Page # 61 / How do I get faith?

Luke 17:5-10 (ESV) **The apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith!"**

- <sup>6</sup> **And the Lord said,** "If you had faith like a grain of mustard seed,  
You could say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,'  
And it would obey you.
- <sup>7</sup> "Will any one of you who has a servant plowing or keeping sheep  
Say to him when he has come in from the field,  
'Come at once and recline at table'?
- <sup>8</sup> Will he not rather say to him, 'Prepare supper for me,  
And dress properly, and serve me while I eat and drink,

- <sup>19</sup> My fruit is better than gold, even fine gold, and my yield than choice silver.
- <sup>20</sup> I walk in the way of righteousness, in the paths of justice,
- <sup>21</sup> Granting an inheritance to those who love Me, and filling their treasuries.

Hebrews 11:1-8 (ESV) **Now faith is the assurance** of things hoped for,  
The conviction of things not seen.

- <sup>2</sup> For by it the people of old received their commendation.
- <sup>3</sup> By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God,  
So that what is seen  
Was not made out of things that are visible.
- <sup>4</sup> By faith Abel offered to God a more acceptable sacrifice than Cain,  
Through which he was commended as righteous,  
God commending him by accepting his gifts.  
And through his faith, though he died, he still speaks.
- <sup>5</sup> By faith Enoch was taken up so that he should not see death,  
And he was not found, because God had taken him.  
Now before he was taken he was commended as having pleased God.
- <sup>6</sup> And without faith it is impossible to please Him,  
For whoever would draw near to God  
Must believe that He exists and that he rewards those who seek him.
- <sup>7</sup> By faith Noah, being warned by God concerning events as yet unseen,  
In reverent fear constructed an ark for the saving of his household.  
By this he condemned the world  
And became an heir of the righteousness that comes by faith.
- <sup>8</sup> By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to a place  
That he was to receive as an inheritance.  
And he went out, not knowing where he was going.

Joshua 1:6-9 (ESV) **Be strong and courageous**, for you shall cause this people

To **inherit** the land **that I swore to** their fathers **to give** them.
